Right click on the package>all tasks > Update distribution points

This will tell you that it is going to send a new copy to all the dps..
Also go in to the package > distribution points> right click on your dps and make sure you see their properties.

Hi,
i have scheduled the sync tool to run at 13pm and in package microsoft tool properties schedule distribution point at 13:30pm.
Is this what you meant by "set the package to autoupdate"?

Earlier i manually entered a comment in package properties to force a change of it and did a update distribution point.
Afterwards i tried running sync tool. I did this because i read in <http://kbalertz.com/909387/advertisement-remote-roaming-Advanced-Clients-after-configure-advertiseme> that this could fix the no DP found issue.

How do i do a manual update on a package? Do i change a setting in the package properties and then distribute it to DP?

It will not fix the DP found problem but it will fix the problem with updating the server and other information. If the content is not up-to-date then the client will not download it. To run the sync the next time. Do a manual update on the package and send it to the DPs. Then tell the sync tool to run. This way the package is updated, sync will run and it will update

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the package again (for the next run).

Also copy the sync in to a batch file or cmd file and run it from the command line to see if the program will run manually. Watch the sync log in the ccm folder to see what happens...

If this works then you can work backwards to make sure it works thru sms.

Hi Matthew,
i dont think that its set to autoupdate after the sync runs.

I can understand that the package should update on a schedule since a new cab file could have been downloaded but so far i havent seen sync tool run succesfully so far.

If i turn update on schedule for the Microsoft Update tool on say like 30 minutes after sync tool runs will that fix the waiting status for sync tool advertisement? And that issue with CAS.log stating no DP point found?

Do you have the package autoupdating after the sync runs. If you have the sync running at 3:30pm every patch tuesday then set the package to autoupdate at say 4:00pm or shorter.

uninstalling sms client.
Im trying to run Microsoft
Sync Tool on the site server.

When i try to run
advertisement for Sync tool
in Advertisement status
it
lists:

The program for
advertisement "SUR20001
has not yet started because

Updates Tool Sync"

When i run report "Status of
a specific advertisement" on
Sync tool i
have
alot of waiting.
I checked CAS.log and this
is what it states:

The advertisements with the same package with Microsoft Tool program runs without problems on two test clients on a daily basis but the Sync tool program/advertisement doesn't run successfully, keeps reporting waiting.

Since the Sync tool runs on the site server that also is dp i do not understand how it cannot locate a matching DP (according to CAS.log)

Anyone have an idea why this might occur and how to resolve this?

I even ran the syncxml.exe
