The "there is a time and/or data difference..." tag is what I would look at. If there is more than 5 minutes universal time difference (It think it's 5 minutes), you'll get all kinds of interesting things with SMS. I'd remote into that server, and check / double-check the time, and the time zone, (and probably the daylight savings time patches / rules) that the computer thinks it is in. I'd also (for me) double-check that the server is correctly setup to get time from the correct timesync source on my domain—so this doesn't happen again.

If you've really checked the date/time, then I'd look into permissions. are the correct computer accounts in the correct local groups on inddel02sm01 to allow for your parent server to send data to inddel02sm01?

Hi

We have one cetral site & 20 seconadry sites . when I update distribution point of one package , Package version is not updateing on one secondary site but it has updated on other secondary sites. error shows in LAN sender log is "The sender cannot connect to remote site "JGP" over the LAN. The operating system reported error 1398: There is a time and/or date difference between the client and server.

Possible cause: Remote site server "INDDEL02SM01" might not be connected to the LAN.

Solution: Verify that site server "INDDEL02SM01" is connected to the LAN and functioning properly.

Possible cause: Share "SMS_SITE" might not be accessible.

Solution: Verify that share "SMS_SITE" is visible and that the site server machine account has the necessary permissions to access the share.

Possible cause: Network load might be too high.

Solution: Verify that the network is not saturated. Verify that you can move

large amounts of data across the network." I have checked all the possible causes , i have not found any problem .
