> in our domain name (Created before my time here).

>

> The issue is specifically related to the MSBA portion of

> the scan. I have run the baseline analyzer as a

> standalone application and I have the same exact issue.

> If you edit the XML and tweak the code to include "apm;"

> after the ampersand in the <DOMAIN> section, the issue

> goes away.

>

> As you can probably see, this is simply not feasible in

> the SMS-SUS scenario due to the sheer # of clients, and

> the fact that MSBA is integrated into the SUS via code.

>
