

# New MSSecure.XML Version 2004.12.01.0 Now Available

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MSSECURE.XML Data Version 2004.12.01.0 (for use by MBSA 1.2 and SMS SUS Feature Pack) was last modified today, December 1, 2004, and is now available for all supported languages (English, French, German and Japanese).

This release fully supports the following new bulletin:

MS04-040 (IE 6 SP1 Cumulative Update) – 889293.

This release also includes a number of minor bug fixes reported by customers and PSS to resolve 'invalid checksum' and 'greater than expected' warnings. It also includes two bug fixes that correctly provide a Note Message for MS02-064 and MS03-008 on Windows 2000 SP4 that were previously set to detect on Windows 2000 Gold, SP1, SP2 and SP3 platforms only.

Note messages do not indicate that the computer that you are scanning is not secure. Note messages indicate that for technical reasons, MBSA cannot determine whether the appropriate update or workaround was applied. You can ignore note messages after you apply the update or after you evaluate your computer to confirm it is secure based on the details provided in the associated MSRC bulletin.
