

Re: Log in problem

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Open Enterprise Manager and right click on the server node. Select Edit SQL Server Registration Properties. From here, make sure to enter the correct SQL login and password. You may also just be experiencing a login time...it's hard to say without the exact error message. If this is the case, in Enterprise Manager go to the menu to tools...options. On the Advanced tab, increase the login timeout from the default 4 secs to something higher....try 15 to start with.
