Hi Phil,

Thanks for the update.

The duration of a query operation is related to several things like the CPU usage, network connection, etc.

Also, if there is other queries executed on the same table, you may receive a different duration time.

As you mentioned, your SQL 2005 is on a different machine, so I think the duration of a query will include the network connection time. The same query will take the same time.

Performance issues can be difficult to troubleshoot and resolve in a newsgroup setting due to the number of variables and the amount of time required to narrow down possible causes and observe the effects. We will assist as best as we can, but you may wish to consider contacting CSS for a more timely resolution for these type issues.
