Using VB .NET is there a way to return/track the reason why a connection has failed to open. I want to be able to track the following reasons for failure:

1. User doesn't have the correct permissions set to open the database
2. Unable to open the connection because the user setting are wrong, (server name, username, password)
3. Using the wrong authentication – NT authentication instead of SQL Server authentication and vis versa
