I am using SQLServer 2000, Visual Studio 2003, C#.

I am writing a web part which requires me to connect to a local sql database.

I wrote a class which handles the connection and reading of the table.

When I try to call .Open on the connection, it fails, the exception is something to do with permission.

I used the same class to connect with a console application and a windows application, and it works fine. I am able to connect and read the table.

Can anyone shed some light on what is the difference between connecting/accessing to a database via Web Application as opposed to a Non-Web App.
