Hi,

We've been asked to enable an external client to access a cube via OWC.

The idea is that if they play about with the cube through the PivotTable control, this will enable them to define their requirements for a reporting system to sit on top of the cube.

I've read and implemented the contents of the following document:-

I've installed OWC and the SQL data access components on a test machine, and have been trying to access the cube through a web-page hosting the pivot table control.

Data access across domains is enabled in IE

The error returned is "The query could not be processed: The HTTP server returned the following error: Forbidden."

Obviously some security setting somewhere needs to be tweaked ... but which one :/

Access to the web-page hosting the OWC control will be locked down by IP address.

Bearing all the above, what is the most straightforward means of enabling access via the OWC PivotTble control?
