Ok, I missed the bit about the stored proc call. Sorry. That will be a bit of a problem as you are breaking the create and execute across VB and SQL. Stick with the save, execute and delete. Use unique names for the packages each time they are created I guess would aoid the clash of concurrent users.

Sorry about that, it's possible I'm sure, but I think the effort would far outweigh any benefit as there are workarounds for your current issues.
