>I have a strange problem that I am having trouble troubleshooting. I need
>to execute a SQL command against an Oracle database using DTS. I created a
>'Microsoft ODBC Driver for Oracle' connection and based an 'Execute SQL'
>task on that connection. When executing the task I get the "Multiple-step
>OLE DB operation generated errors" message. The strange thing is that if I
>go into properties of the Execute SQL task and click 'Build Query', I can
>execute the query just fine in the query builder. Do you have any
>suggestions on how I can troubleshoot this problem? Why does the query
>builder work but the Execute SQL task doesn't. PS I also tried the
>'Microsoft OLE DB Provider for Oracle' with the same results.
>Any help would be appreciated. Thanks.
