I get the above error when I run a very simple DTS package to copy a database from my production server to my development server. This has always worked in the past. Unfortunately, it does not tell me which table is causing the error (and 200 tables, so I don't want to run it for each one). Using the database import/export wizard to do the copying gives the same problem.

I ran dbcc checkdb, but that reports no problems and did not help. Any suggestions?
