Mostly MS are recommending integrated security over SQL Authentication – not just for DTS. The reasons for this are that the password doesn't need storing anywhere, and the restrictions that come with Windows passwords can be applied – complexity, can't use previous passwords, can restrict as soon as someone leaves, use of windows groups etc....I'd guess that the general recommendation is to only use SQL Authentication for untrusted situations – working accross domains, unix clients, working over the internet etc.
