Try:

```
SELECT Score_Min=MIN(b.Score),
Score_Min_PersonID=(select personid from Scores a
  where a.score = min(b.score)),
Score_Max=MAX(b.Score),
Score_Max_PersonID=(select personid from Scores a
  where a.score = max(b.score))
FROM dbo.Scores b
WHERE Score <> 0
```

Make sure that you have only one row for each of the max(score) and min(score) otherwise you will get an error as

"Subquery returned more than 1 value....."
