to avoid using cursor, i create a temporary table like this:

```
create table #INS_DETAIL
```

```
(  
  SN int not null identity, --  
  COMMODITY_CODE varchar(10) not null, --  
  LIMIT_PRICE decimal(10, 3) not null default 0.00, --  
  LIMIT_QTY decimal(15, 0) not null default 0.00, --  
)
```

insert #INS_DETAIL (COMMODITY_CODE, LIMIT_PRICE, LIMIT_QTY)  
  select COMMODITY_CODE, LIMIT_PRICE, 9
```

drop table #INS_DETAIL
```

but sometimes the very error encountered: field 'LIMIT\_QTY' doesn't exist.  
if i change the temporary table name or delete the filed LIMIT\_QTY, it's OK.  
what's wrong? thanks in advance.
