>I was part of the dev team which did version 1.0 and 1.1 -- then SSABI
>transitioned to a different group so I can only comment on the core
>techniques we used; not 1.2 specifics.

>

> Origionlly we wrote it for checks with SP1 only. It looks for a build#
> larger than a particularly value. Unfortunately, then the office guys
> changed how they number their builds and it broke the validation checks.
> The only time this is used is during install time (again I can speak for
> 1.0 and 1.1 only). The only real workaround that I have is to go back to
> SP1 (may need an Office re-install); then install SSABI; then upgrade to
> the later Office pack.
