FYI, the "inserted" table does not really exist, it is a view across entries in the transaction log. Therefore, non-updateable. You could, of course, reupdate the row in the base table, but think about that and recursive issues before you do it.

> *Is there any way to declare a variable so that I can set the value in one trigger (that sets a status to indicate a duplicate record) and have it read into a second trigger (that writes that status to an audit trail?)* I've tried a couple of different ideas to get this status to write correctly and it doesn't seem to work. The easiest way would be to update the "inserted" table, but it says it doesn't allow that.
