There isn't any way to really do what your after. If they have access to run profiler (or even a network monitor) they can see your code. You can (and probably should) use stored procedures and use the with Encryption option which can help. But that will not stop a dedicated hacker. You need to protect yourself with a good copywrite policy.
