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Hi:

I am starting to rip my hair out. I pretty much tried everything. I want to insert following values:

sqlString = "INSERT into myTable (ProductID, Name, Title, CategoryID,
Organization, Address, City, State, Zip, Country, Phone, Fax, Email,
Heard, Referral, Computer, Implement, Description, RepMail, Counter,
Password, Authenticated, Created, LastAccessed) VALUES (" &
strSoftware & "," & strName & "," & strTitle & "," & strInst &
"," & strOrganization & "," & strAddress & "," & strCity &
"," & strState & "," & strPostal & "," & strCountry & "," &
strPhone & "," & strFax & "," & strEmail & "," & strHeard &
"," & strReferral & "," & strComputer & "," & strImplement &
"," & strDescription & "," & strRepMail & "," & "0" & "," &
strPassword & "," & "0" & "," & formatdatetime(now,2) & "," &
formatdatetime(now,2) & ")"
