Thanks for your post and please understand that we will usually response within 24 hours as we are in East Asian :)

>From your descriptions, I understood that everything was OK before you applying hotfix of SQL Server 2000, however, you encounter error 0x80070005 for debugging stored procedure in XP after installing the hotfix. Have I understood you? Correct me if I was wrong.

First of all, would you please let me know what hotfix you had applied?

Secondly, is it possible for your to change the SQL Server startup account from 'NT AUTHORITY\SYSTEM' to a Domain Account, which has administrator authority, and let me know whether this resolve your issue.

Thirdly, check to see if the client and the server do not have any firewall between them. Disable the firewall and then try again.

Fourthly, on the client machine, make sure DCOM was enabled by the following steps

--run dcomcnfg.

--Go to the dcom config properties under default properties, there is a check box stating "enable Distributed COM on this computer", this is a default setting that is checked.

If all these above does help, please let me know the detailed information shown in Error Log (System Log and Application Log).
