```
SELECT * FROM
dbo.MonthlyUnapprovedTime
WHERE EmployeeID = 123456
AND uMonth <= datepart(m,'5/1/2004')
AND uYear <= datepart(yyyy,'5/1/2004')
```

On the table below

```
[dbo].[MONTHLYUNAPPROVEDTIME]
([MU_ID] [int] IDENTITY (1, 1) NOT NULL ,
 [EmployeeID] [char] (3) [int] NOT NULL ,
 [uMonth] [int] NOT NULL ,
 [uYear] [int] NOT NULL ,
 [UnapprovedTime] [decimal](5, 2) NOT NULL)
```
