I have used Enterprise Manager to configure replication on SERVER1. SERVER1 is the Distributor and the Publisher. SERVER1 is a SQL Server 2000 that runs in mixed mode (SQL and Windows Authentication). The SQL Server and SQL Server Agent startup accounts are the same which is also a local user account that has administrative privileges.

I am completely stumped why I am having these permissions issues when everything is being done on the local machine.
