> *There is a table in the tempdb database that contains the status of the agents. If the status is incorrectly displayed, there are two options to resolve the issue:*

> *1. Restart SQL Server. Tempdb is recreated whenever SQL Server starts, so this cleans up the incorrect status.*

> *2. Manually delete the row with the incorrect status. Because this involved modifying a system table, I won't tell you exactly which table it is, but I think you'll be able to figure it out by looking at the tables in*

> *the tempdb database :-)*
