I have a couple of servers in my test region that I am trying to configure in an Updating Subscriber replication configuration. I am able to set up the publisher without issue. The distributor is on the same server as the publisher. I can create a subscription to the second server. When updating a column for a publication, the row updates to the subscriber without a problem. However, when updating the same column on the subscriber, I receive the following error message:

Could not locate entry in sysdatabases for database 'central' No entry found with that name. Make sure that the name is entered correctly.

The 'central' database is the publishing database on the first server and would not have an entry in the sysdatabases table on the subscriber. Does anyone know why I am getting this message.
