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There are default constraints on that field. You'll have to drop those constraints before dropping the column itself. you should do a select on sysobjects to find the default constraints like '%df\_%\_msrepl%'. i would assume, replication is not in place(immediate updating or queued updating). Once you drop the constraint, it lets u drop the column.
