I want to split transactions in transaction replications SQL2k, in case if the transaction is too huge. I think about setting MaxCmdInTran to 1000000 for logreader and similar for distribution agent. In current DB schema such transactions should never occur. But in case if the transaction happened, I want to get at least fact what the splitting happened. Is any way to find such cases, when transaction was splitted by replication?
