Thanks for your reply. Well, I installed SYbase SDK 12.5.1 with the OLEDB provider and, believe or not, managed to connect to my sybase server. My serious issue was @subscriber_provider, as I somehow defined the rest from the list. This is actually supposed to be 'Sybase.ASEOLEDBProvider'. After setting that up by running sp_changesubscriber I connected to the test database. Mind you, I set it up through the scripts, as it wasn't possible to do it through the GUI.

I can give you more information later when I see how the testing goes.
