My organization is running SQL Server 2000 on a Windows 2000 server. We have a maintenance plan set up to perform a daily backup of several database files. The full database backup runs each day at 2:00 a.m. The transaction log backup runs every four hours. It is setup in the maintenance plan that the checkbox for both the data file and transaction log that says "Remove files older than" is checked and set for 2 days. However, the old transaction log backup files (*.TRN) are not being automatically removed. The regular database files (*.BAK) are removed just fine. Any suggestions?
