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```
SELECT 'GRANT EXEC ON [' + routine_name + '] TO Nikolay'
FROM information_schema.routines
WHERE routine_type = 'PROCEDURE'
AND OBJECTPROPERTY(OBJECT_ID(routine_name), 'IsMSShipped') = 0
```

Run the above in Query Analyzer with results to text, and run the resulting script. As long as you haven't granted any permissions to the public role those are the only permissions your user will have. IF there are, you can use the above with DENY and information_schema.tables etc.
