I think you are referring to the ability to encrypt source code. SQL Server supports a WITH ENCRYPTION option on CREATE PROC, VIEW and FUNCTION statements. Unfortunately, the encryption method isn't very secure. It is easily broken with freely downloadable tools.

There are third party tools that claim to help secure your SQL Server code. You can Google for those.
