Do you mean from a T-SQL script? The utility just writes to the registration database. Sniff the regdb while you perform adding a new alias and see where it goes. Then you can use any programming tool or just a .reg file to add the new data to everyones PC. From a domain this is easy.

You can sniff the regdb using free tools from www.sysinternals.com
