Hello!

I would like to allow non-admin users seeing all jobs (including ones they do now own) in Enterprise Manager. SQL Profiler displays execution of `exec msdb..sp_help_job` when querying job list. According to BOL: 'A user who is not a member of the sysadmin fixed role can use `sp_help_job` to view only the jobs he/she owns.'. I suppose `xp_sqlagent_proxy_account` wouldn't be of any help in this case. Is this possible for non-admin users to see all jobs?
