Currently, our network/server/domain admins have admin control of our sql servers. One manager wants to run sql under a special local admin account to restrict this access, but then we will be effected by the password change requirement, which could break sql every 90 days.

What is the best way to run sql so that the server admins don't have sql admin access? Can I run it under "local system", and restrict machine admins?
