I'm trying to rebuild MS DTC services on an SQL 2000 server (SP3a) located on a Windows NT 4.0 server. (with latest service packs.)

I found the following article:

<http://support.microsoft.com/default.aspx?scid=kb:en-us:294209> states the following quote: "You can find the MSDTC setup on the SQL Server Service Pack 2 CD in the \x86\Other folder listed as Dtcsetup.exe, which should be your source on Windows NT 4.0 systems."

I don't have a copy of the SQL 2000 SP 2 available and the service pack downloads don't seem to include the file either. However, I can find many instances of DTCSetup.exe throughout my network of SQL servers. Is there a particular version number of DTCSetup.exe that would work just as well? Or can I simply download the correct version from your site(s)?
