- New: Spanish city and street names
- New: Spanish male and female first names and Spanish last names
- Enhancements: improved error reporting when loading projects with missing presets
- Enhancement: added ability to truncate random Float values
- Enhancement: added ability take a random value from all streetnames
- Fixed: fixed type problems for database engines that don't return parameter datatypes (like Gupta, PostgreSQL etc...)
- Fixed: ADG had problems saving presets (and others) with accented characters in names
- Fixed: fixed a problem if you were using {F:...} for Masked Values as the only command
