Team;

I've been getting nothing but errors recently; as I've been using maintenance plans.

Here is one of the error logs.

Executing the query "EXECUTE master.dbo.xp_delete_file 0,N",N",N'2008-03-14T00:56:18' " failed with the following error: "Error executing extended stored procedure: Invalid Parameter". Possible failure reasons: Problems with the query, "ResultSet" property not set correctly, parameters not set correctly, or connection not established correctly.

I really haven't done anything too fishy with this maint plan; I've been kinda struggling with these maint plan— I mean it should be EASY to setup, right?

I just basically.. have a db that I want to run maint plan on; and take a backup.
I don't have enough room to store more than 2 backups.

So I told the main plan to clean up BAK files that are more than 8 days old.
