The following two examples do not work! What am I doing wrong.

```
var uuuuuu = document.FORM1.txtEnrl.value;
var vvvvvv = document.FORM1.txtNoSnrs.value;

if ((vvvvvv) > (uuuuuu)){
```

The value of a <input type=text> is ALWAYS a string.
Putting a string in () does not make it a number.
Comparing strings compares alphanumeric.

Try:

```
if (+vvvvvv > +uuuuuu){
```

I do as little as possible with Jscript, I am a vbScript man!

Then you should already know this,
as the same compare problem,
though not the solution,
goes for [clientside] vbs.

You see, doing some javascript can improve your vbs skills.
