

Re: Delete all files in certain folders across multiple users

Seeing that you wish to delete all files in the UserData folder, why not delete the parent %UserName% folder? It would simplify your job considerably!

You also need to state if you want to delete the files in the nominated ***folders*** or in the ***folder trees***.

Lastly: If you want to use this as an exercise in VB scripting, fine. If you just want a tool to do the job then a batch file would require far fewer lines of code, largely because can use commands with inbuilt recursive facilities. With VB Scripting you have to design them yourself.
