I'm working on a vbscript, which will be added to our logon script. The script will query our SQL server and generate a signature file and save it to a folder under user's profile. For example, the file is called company.htm and will be saved at c:\documents and settings\<userid>\application data\microsoft\signatures. How can I define the path in the script so the file will be saved properly under each profile. Some computers are shared by roaming users. I'm sure it's very easy but I'm not good at vbscript so please help.

You can extract an environmental variable like so:
Set objWshShell = WScript.CreateObject("WScript.Shell")
WScript.Echo "UserProfile=" &
objWshShell.Environment("PROCESS")("UserProfile")
