We have some ASP pages on the corporate intranet that report various business statistics. We would like to capture a snapshot of these reports each night about midnight by running a scheduled script.

We've been unsuccessful at finding any examples of how a script can capture a web page, preferably to an internet archive file (MHT).

We've been able to build a kludge using Word VBA to generate an HTML file, but it requires some cleanup after capture. We were hoping for something that might do the equivalent of IE's File>Save As>Web Archive, but from script.

Any help would be appreciated.
