logfileobj.WriteLine strGFI.Name & " was moved to " & cDEST & " at
" & now
Next
```

The problem is I cannot get strGFI.Name to echo anything to my logfile. I have tried many different solutions and searched the groups to the best of my ability, but I'm still in the early stages of scripting and don't know how to express what I am trying to do in the proper terms.
