I have this script in example1.vbs:

```
Dim objshell, objnetworkk
Set objshell = WScript.CreateObject("Wscript.Shell")
Set objnetwork = WScript.CreateObject("Wscript.Network")
```

```
Dim vdom, vuser
Set vdom = objnetwork.UserDomain
Set vuser = objnetwork.UserName
wscript.echo "Welcome to the domain: " & vdom & ", " & vuser & " ."
```

when i execute this command with csript example1.vbs y have this response.  
Object is requied [string: "Mydomainname"]

Don't use "set" when you assign values to the string variables. Use:

```
vdom = objnetwork.UserDomain
Set vuser = objnetwork.UserName
```

Only use "Set" to assign object references, like objNetwork.
