There are a lot of <SPSWC> tag in the code and we want to take out some of them (e.g. <SPSWC:CategoryNavigationWebPart>) However, since we are told by MS consultant not to delete those code but make it invisible to the user (i.e. using the tracking of -----> style="visibility:hidden"). But the problem is, even though I had put <div style="visibility:hidden;position:absolute;width:0px;"> around the <SPSWC> tag of CategoryNavigationWebPart. That bar of navigation was indeed disappear but there is a small rectangle frame in the page instead. Does anybody knows how to get rid of it without deleting them? Thanks!!!
