Hello Friends,

I am new to SharePoint Portal server 2003.

I am trying to integrate Microsoft Windows workflow from sharepoint portal server 2003. I have installed Sharepointportal server 2003 on windows server 2003, Visual studio 2003, office 2000 and SQL server 2000.

All the components are running on single server (there is only one computer where all these are installed). Sharepoint portal server is running fine

I have read that windows workflow works with .Net framework 2.0 and sharepoint portal server 2003 works with .Net Framework 1.1

1. Is it possible that windows workflow can work with sharepoint portal server2003?
2. If possible, how can I invoke workflow which is developed using Visual Studio 2005?
3. Is it possible invoking workflow using webpart?
4. What else I need to install on my server?
5. If I install .Net framework 2.0(Visual studio 2005) on this machine where sharepoint portal server 2003 and visual studio 2003 installed, Will this installation create any problem?
