> > > > portal server. When deploying web parts, I am able to add them via  
> the  
> > > > browser without any error. However, I can't add them through  
> Frontpage,

> > > > even open a file with one in it (in Frontpage). I receive a "server

> > > > not complete your request" error. The details display a soap  
> exception  
> > > > relating to an unsafe webpart. If I delete the web part through the  
> > > > browser, no problem, the files open in Frontpage. I'm assuming this  
> is  
> > > some  
> > > > sort of  
> > > > configuration issue we've created with SPS, since it worked fine  
with  
> > WSS,  
> > > > but I'm not sure what that issue is. An error shows up in the event  
> log  
> > > > when I try to open the page using Frontpage (Failure in loading  
> > assembly,  
> > > > event id 1000). I have seen posts on this, but none of the  
suggested  
> > > > solutions (i.e. all unassigned ip's) have worked. Any other  
> > suggestions?  
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
