My site was named "home". If a user typed "<http://home> into the address bar in IE they got a login prompt from the portal. If they type in <http://10.0.0.2> (which is the server's IP address, then they were taken straight to the site without the login prompt.

And yes, you can ping "Home" and "10.0.0.2" and both are successful.
