Paul, The 'My Sites' functionality is enabled. We use alerts extensively and that's been working great. I've walked through the setup on public folders on two different sps boxes and is still get the same error in the log.

I am out of ideas from my personal experience. So, I took the error message to google and let them do a search. The second entry points to an article in Technet about a Don't restart timer service parameter, and then I did a search from the Technet page on just the first part of the error message and found the following:

The error message there is not quite the same and the UrlScan tool is to blame. You might check to see if you are using that.

If that doesn't work, then there are lots of other leads to chase down from the Google results set. If that doesn't lead to success, then a support call to PSSST is indicated.

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
