> *Question: Is it possible to create a SPTS Workflow application without Office XP Developer Edition?*  
> *I have SPTS installed on a Windows 2000 Advanced Server running SQL Server 2000 for the database system.*  
> *For a development platform, I have SPTS installed on a Windows XP Professional box running the MSDE (version 7 I believe) version that is installed by default by the SPTS setup program.*  
> *For development tools, I have FrontPage 2002, Visual InterDev 6.0, and SQL Server 2000 Enterprise Tools.*  
> *Our office will be upgrading to Office 2003 in the near future. If I don't HAVE to purchase a copy of Office XP Developer Edition, obviously, I want to avoid it. Will any of the tools I currently have available (listed above) allow me to create a Workflow application in SPTS or will a copy of Office 2003 Professional enable that for me?*  
> *We do have Windows 2003 Server, however at this point we cannot migrate to IIS 6 and Windows SharePoint Services because we use a version of Crystal Reports that does not function on IIS 6 and it's not in the budget to run two web servers for the intranet, so I am limited to using a 2000 Server box running IIS 5.*
