Initially when the client enters there WSS 3.0 Site they are receiving a login prompt at the first main site, then they are able to access all sites without any logging prompts. However, if they want to access a document in a document library for reading or editing they have to type in the username and password. None of these people are accessing the WSS Sites from a shared domain like an extranet site. I was looking all over the web for various solutions, such as Integrated Authentication Method and Making the Site Trusted. The read only solution to open up documents is unacceptable as they want to open them up in both edit and read only. None of these solutions have worked for this problem. Does anyone have any other suggestions?
