I should also note, when i try and start this and it fails, if i go into the event viewer there are a number of errors coming up. I have done some searching and have found some resolutions that people were not placing there domain name in front of the user name to access rights. I have tried placing the domain in front of the username and have given this user admin rights on both the sql server and this sharepoint server none of which have worked. Here are the errors I am getting.

The uninstall and reinstall of .net framework 2 and 3 as well as sharepoint must have fixed it as I have it installed. However I am running into another issue.

I am following the MSinstallinstructions (Deployment for Windows SharePoint Services 3.0 technology) and am at the portion "Start the Windows SharePoint Services Search service".

I click to "Start" the service and then enter in the domain\username and password for the service account and content access account which both use the same username/password. The first time it chugged along for maybe 15 seconds then it came up saying Error "File Not Found"

Troubleshoot issues with Windows SharePoint Services. (I have clicked on this and it didn't work before doing a reinstall of sharepoint. Once reinstalled, help comes up but there is no solution but I still get this same error) Now when i try it over again this same eror appears after around 5 seconds of chugging along.

The database has been built. I can see it on our SQL server.

What is this error?

1GB is enough. MOSS needs at least 1GB otherwise there are config wizard errors but WSS 3.0 is OK with much less.

After choosing Advancedinstallyou should during the installation process (i.e. before the wizard) be asked which database system you are connecting to. From what you say you didn't get this.

I'm wondering which alternative you chose after choosing AdvancedInstall.

If you do decide to start again. Back out everything on that server (Remove Programs ...) including both .NET Framework 3.0 *and* 2.0. Then run .NET Framework 3.0 again and the WSSinstall. Key is also that you have given whatever you are installing WSS as sufficient rights to the SQL Server system.

Let us also know which Microsoft (or other) installation instructions you were following.
